- Oversee annual Chicago fundraising event and grassroots fundraising programs
- Recruit new communal and campus-based Sharsheret program participants
- Supervise 1 outreach professional to ensure that the office meets fundraising and outreach objectives as identified annually
- Cultivate a team of all regional staff members, including clinical staff members
- Manage and provide leadership development opportunities for the Community Advisory Committee and other regional lay leaders
- Represent Sharsheret at local conferences, parlor meetings, and campus events
