Are You ESR1 Out of 2? Get Tested. Know Your Status.

Nearly 1 out of 2 people with ER+/HER2- metastatic breast cancer will develop an ESR1 mutation as a result of exposure to hormone therapy. The ESR1 mutation can occur when cancer changes in an attempt to evade treatments. This mutation can make your mBC harder to treat, but the good news is that there is a treatment for appropriate patients with ESR1-mutated advanced or metastatic breast cancer. A simple blood draw can help determine if your cancer has developed this mutation. Do you know your ESR1 status?
