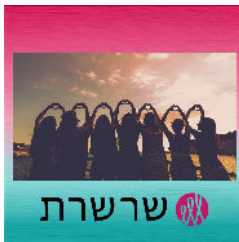
3rd Annual West Coast Dash

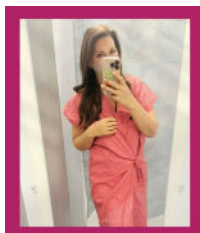
