Dr. Fox is a board-certified Obstetrician/Gynecologist with subspecialty certification in Maternal Fetal Medicine. He serves as a Clinical Professor in the Department of Obstetrics, Gynecology, and Reproductive Science at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, where he has received numerous teaching awards and mentors students across all levels of medical education. A practicing specialist at Maternal Fetal Medicine Associates and Carnegie Imaging for Women in New York City, Dr. Fox is internationally recognized for his expertise in high-risk pregnancies, diagnostic ultrasound, and fetal diagnosis. His research has led to numerous peer-reviewed publications and he currently serves on the editorial board of *Obstetrics and Gynecology*, the leading journal in the field.

Throughout his career, Dr. Fox has provided exceptional care to women navigating pregnancy after a cancer diagnosis, making him a powerful advocate for Sharsheret's mission. His relationship with Sharsheret began in 2011, when he ran the TCS New York City Marathon as part of Team Sharsheret, finishing in 3:52:20. Natie also served as a champion on Sharsheret's 20th anniversary streaming fundraiser, *20/21 Tonight*. Since then, he has remained deeply committed to the organization's mission, expressing profound gratitude for the care and community Sharsheret provides to his patients. Dr. Fox is also the host of the *Healthful Woman Podcast*, one of the fastest-growing women's health podcasts, and co-author of *The Unexpected: Navigating Pregnancy During and After Complications*. He lives in Englewood, NJ with his wife Michal, a school psychologist, and their five children: Noam, Kira and Elan Cooper, Nili, and Mia.
