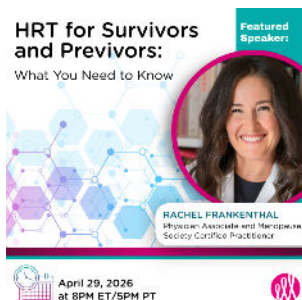


In Florida for Passover? Join Us for a Walk!

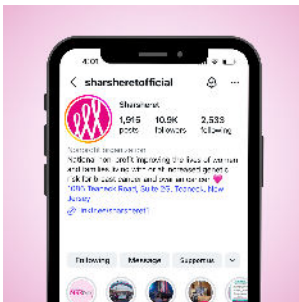
