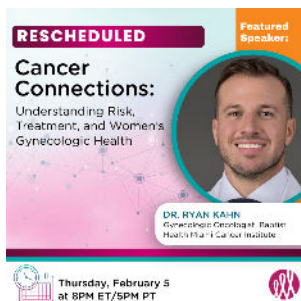

Rescheduled Webinar: Understanding Risk, Treatment, and Women's Gynecologic Health

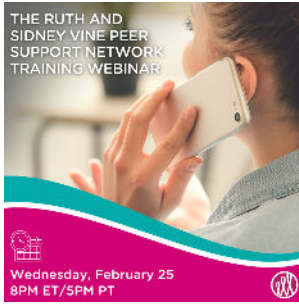
