NEW SHARSHERET PROGRAM EDUCATES LOCAL SUPPORT GROUP LEADERS

Sharsheret has developed **Sharsheret Supports**, a new program to educate support group leaders about the unique concerns of Jewish women and families living with breast cancer. The program includes facilitator training and resources to assist in beginning and sustaining a culturally-sensitive breast cancer support group. A National Resource Directory will help identify Jewish organizations and cancer organizations that can be shared with support group members. Sharsheret will also provide support group leaders with suggested topics addressing pertinent issues such as hereditary breast cancer and ovarian cancer in Jewish families and the impact of cancer on Jewish ritual, as a springboard for discussions among group members. Additionally, support group leaders can utilize the consultation services of Sharsheret representatives who can provide facilitator training and lead sample support sessions.
