SHARSHERET'S FLORIDA OFFICE CELEBRATES ITS FIRST ANNIVERSARY

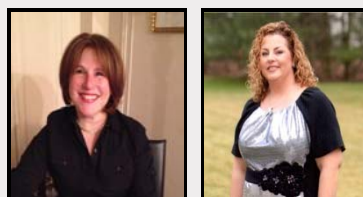
